



If you're unsure whether your outfit meets the dress code, just get in touch before the match day to avoid any surprises at the gate.

CRICKET ETIQUETTE

RESPECT THE GAME. RESPECT EACH OTHER.

Whether you're cheering from the boundary or hosting a guest in the Members Reserve, we ask that you uphold the spirit of the game by observing these simple courtesies:

RESPECT THE MOMENT

Please remain seated during an over. If you need to leave your seat, do so between overs or at a natural break in play.

Keep conversations low and avoid shouting while the bowler is running in.

RESPECT YOUR FELLOW MEMBERS

Be courteous to those around you - this includes not standing in aisles or blocking views.

Please use mobile phones discretely or take phone calls outside seating areas, and dispose of rubbish thoughtfully.



RESPECT THE ATMOSPHERE

Enjoy a drink, but drink responsibly. Intoxicated behaviour will not be tolerated.

Offensive language, abuse of players, umpires, staff or fellow spectators is strictly prohibited and may result in removal.

Applaud good play from both teams - it's the cricketing way.

Refrain from sledging. Leave the banter to the professionals.

RESPECT SHARED SPACES

Seats in the Members Reserve are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. Please do not save seats with personal items, allowing all Members a fair chance to enjoy the match.

Easy access seating is provided for those who require it.

Please respect the directions of our staff if you are asked to move to accommodate a fellow patron who needs this area.



MEMBER CODE OF CONDUCT

WA Cricket expects and requires all Members to be active and united in upholding the highest standards of conduct and behaviour to:

- protect the health and safety of the WA Cricket's workers, agents and officers;

- create an enjoyable, safe and respectful environment for Members and their guests; and

- protect the good reputation and standing of WA Cricket

The Members Code of Conduct applies to all Members and all Members must comply with this Code of Conduct:

- when attending any activity or event held or arranged by WA Cricket (including attending any venue owned or operated by the Organisation);

- when attending any other venue in areas designated for access by WACA Members or when using their WACA membership to enter that venue (Other Member Venues); and

- in all dealings with other Members, WA Cricket and its staff, contractors and representatives (including on social media where there is a connection with WA Cricket).

Members must not engage in conduct that is unbecoming, prejudicial to the interests of WA Cricket, or likely to impair or negatively affect other Members, their guests, or visitors in enjoying the benefits of membership.

This includes, but is not limited to:

- racist, sexist, homophobic, discriminatory, offensive, aggressive, obscene or otherwise inappropriate language or actions towards or in respect of any other person;

- abuse, bullying, victimisation, vilification or harassment of any kind, whether it be physical, verbal or otherwise;

- inappropriate physical contact;

- provocation or incitement of hatred, violence or inappropriate conduct towards any other person;

- disruption or interruption (including attempted disruption or interruption) of any matches or other activities at the WACA Ground, Optus Stadium or Other Member Venues;

- misusing, defacing, damaging or removing (or attempt to do the same) any part of the WACA Ground, Optus Stadium or Other Member Venues;

- drunk or disorderly conduct on or near the WACA Ground, Optus Stadium or Other Member Venues;

- possession or use of illicit substances on or near the WACA Ground, Optus Stadium or Other Member Venues;

- conduct that is unsafe or unlawful;

- abuse of, harassment of, or inappropriate or disrespectful conduct towards, any of WA Cricket's workers, agents or officers at any time, whether it occurs in person, online or by any other means or media;

- non-compliance with lawful directions, instructions or requests by WA Cricket's workers, agents or officers;

- illegal gambling on or near the WACA Ground, Optus Stadium or Other Member Venues;

- misuse of Membership Card or membership entitlements;

- acting dishonestly in any dealings with WA Cricket;

- non-compliance with WA Cricket's dress requirements;

- conduct that amounts to a material or persistent breach of the WACA Constitution or By-Laws; and any other behaviour that brings the Member or WA Cricket into disrepute.

Members are expected to understand and abide by this Code of Conduct. Each Member is also responsible for ensuring their guests or visitors understand WA Crickets' expectations regarding appropriate conduct and behaviour.

In support of creating a safe and respectful environment for all, penalties for breaching the code of conduct apply, as laid out in our Member Penalty Guide available **via the QR code below.**

Your All Access Membership gives you access to unreserved seating throughout the summer - with different options depending on the match type:

International matches: Unreserved seating is located on the shaded northern side of Optus Stadium on Level 1, as well as Level 5 outside of any reserved sections.

BBL matches: Unreserved seating is available on Level 1 (outside the reserved seat bays), and across Level 5.

RESERVED SEATING

Enjoy the best view in the house with a reserved seat!

International matches: Reserved seats will be available in sections 120, 121, 122, and the front of sections 517, 518 and 519.

BBL matches: Reserved seats remain available in sections 120 and 121 on Level 1.

You can secure a reserved seat for the entire summer, or for individual matches you plan to attend. Reserved seating will go on sale closer to the season - simply log in to your Member Portal to book.

Pricing varies by match format and fixture.

Please note that access to the venue is required in addition to reserved seating.





